

# NEMO, ALL FICTION?

## Objective

---

Students will be able to write an informative article or story that explains how fish behave to live and survive in their environment by interacting with living and non-living elements. At least five accurate fish behaviors must be included.

## Materials Needed

---

- DVD of "Nemo"
- Chart paper and markers

## Directions

---

1. Have students view the portion of "Nemo" that shows Nemo and his fish friends interacting with each other and their aquarium environment.
2. Using chart paper and markers, have students write their ideas on a class Venn diagram comparing how Nemo and his friends behave, how fish in the wild behave, and how both groups are the same.
3. Students write an informative article or story that depicts the day in the life of a real fish living in the wild. Explain the need to include at least five accurate fish behaviors.
