

GERBIL FINGER PUPPET

Objective

A Gerbil Finger Puppet encourages kids to make their own adventures.

Materials Needed

- Two 1" foam balls
- 1 black skinny pipe cleaner
- Seven 3" pieces of pipe cleaner
- Googly eyes
- Paint brush
- Felt scraps, pom-poms, yarn
- Scissors
- Craft glue
- Toothpicks

Directions

1. Paint foam balls. Hold the ball with a toothpick while you're painting.
2. Shape pipe cleaner into a U. Dip ends in glue and push into two balls so U shape slips under child's finger. The two balls sit atop the hand and form the puppet's eyes.
3. Glue googly eyes to felt piece or attach directly to foam balls. Glue on felt or pom-pom as nose and eyelids.
4. Glue on pipe cleaner or yarn as whiskers.
5. Form to resemble a Gerbil.
